



2018 Cub Winter Fun Day

All packs and dens will be given time for lunch. A bowl of hot soup and hot sandwich make a nice meal to feed hungry cubs and leaders plus 2 staff members! Be sure to prepare more than enough for all, this will be the only meal throughout the day. Staying warm is vital to survive in the cold of winter, so dress accordingly. Wise Lodge will be available for those that need a place to warm up. A Patch will be given to all those who paid for the day's events.

Any registration received after this date will be charged \$8.00 per person

There may be no more than (10) boys in each Pack group to ensure that the stations can run smoothly and not become over crowded. Groups may consist of mixed ranks and is encouraged. Please bring at least 2 adults for each group, with a minimum of 2 adults. Remember, Lion and Tigers **MUST** have an adult partner with each scout. Lion and Tiger Parents do not need to pay unless they are being counted as leaders for the group.

If your Pack has more than 1 group they **WILL NOT** be at the same station together!

Please bring completed roster with you to registration on February 24.

The cost of the event will be \$6.00 for each individual. There must be a minimum of 2 leaders. All leaders **MUST** be paid. No refunds will be given for individuals that don't show up. Please enclose the correct amount for each person attending the event. Extra patches will be available for purchase after the event for \$3.00 while supplies last.

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Tips for the Pack :

- Minimum of 2 adults (if you have more than 1 group of 10 scouts, there must be 2 adults with each group). Lion and Tiger Cubs must have an adult partner with them. (There is no charge for the adult partners **if** they do not count as one of the Leaders).
- No group will be more than 10 scouts. This is to help with the management of the activities. We suggest combining the different rank levels together as the activities are not separated by age groups.
- **CAR POOL CAR POOL CAR POOL. THERE WILL BE NO PARKING ALONG CAMP LAVIGNE ROAD!** Remember: it is winter (plowed snow) and the parking in the lot will not hold everyone if you drive separately.
- Make sure your scouts are dressed for the weather and bring extra dry clothing.
Hats, boots and gloves are a must. Snow pants are great also if they have them.
- It is YOUR responsibility to keep control of your scouts. Fishing Creek is off limits!
- Plan on bringing a hot lunch to be made/ warmed on a propane stove. The stoves are to be run by the adults only. This is a tailgate meal. Water will be available at Wise Memorial Lodge, bring your own containers to be filled in the kitchen sink. Please plan on feeding 2 staff members.
- No electricity is available for crock pots, etc.
- Wise Lodge restrooms are for adult use only. Portapots are for the youth.
- Wise Lodge will have coffee for the adults and Hot Chocolate for the scouts. It will be closed during Lunch so staff can eat with you.
- If you have a person who is cold, please bring them to Wise Lodge. We will have a fire to warm them up- otherwise please remind all in your unit to refrain from entering the building.
- Memorial Pavilion, next to Wise Lodge is off limits. It will be used as an activity site.
- Approved Fire Rings only, must have a minimum of 12” clear space under ring with no holes where ash may fall. **NO GROUND FIRE**
- All Trash **MUST** be taken from camp, No Dumpster Available.

- CHECK IN: Please wait till all of your scouts are gathered (another reason to CARPOOL) before coming into the Registration area (backroom of Wise Lodge).
 - Bring completed roster of everyone who is at camp, adults also. Please indicate which adults are paid, and which adults are assisting with the day. Form is provided. Things will move faster if this is completed before you check in. **HAVE A COPY FOR YOURSELF.**
- **Leaders Meeting:** One adult per group **MUST** attend this meeting, others are to stay with the scouts. (Another reason to have a minimum of 2 deep leadership). You will be given a schedule of where you are to be for the activity sessions. If you start on the Dining Hall side in the morning you will stay there until Lunch. After Lunch you will do the activities on Wise Lodge side of camp. Likewise for those who start on Wise Lodge side in the morning, you will stay there until Lunch and then go to the Dining Hall side after Lunch.
 - Any changes in schedule will be given at this time
 - Evaluation form will be given out.
 - Procedure for awards and closing ceremony explained.

Take this information back to the other adults and then assemble at the Flag pole in front of Wise Lodge for the Flag ceremony.
